

## Setup

Shuffle all Investment cards together to form a single face down deck, then shuffle all Manager cards together to form a separate face down deck. Place both piles in the center of the table.



The game takes place over 3 rounds. At the start of each round, each player is dealt a manager, which they keep hidden until the end of the round. Investment cards are dealt from the draw pile face-down to each player.

- 2 Player Game 10 Cards
- 3 Player Game 9 Cards
- 4 Player Game 8 Cards
- 5 Player Game 7 Cards

### **Playing a Round**

**Ending a Round** 

1) Each player simultaneously chooses 1 card from their hand and places it face-down in from of them. 2) When each player has done this, all players count down from 3 and yell "Blitz" upon revealing their card.

3) All face-up cards chosen by a player remains with that player until the end of a round.

4) Once cards have been revealed each player passes their remaining face-down hand to the player on their left and the next turn begins.



1) All players continue the card selection process until all cards are chosen by players and placed faceup.

2) Each player reveals their manager and scoring is calculated for the round.

3) Each of the 3 Swag items is compared between all players. The player with the most of a single swag type earn 3 Billion. Players can earn a total of 9 Billion from Swag. Split and round down ties.

4) A scorekeeper takes note of the rounds score.

#### **Starting a New Round**

1) Discard your Investments (except Oil and Bank). 2) Discard your Manager (Except Derrick Plainview) 3) Deal each player a new Investment hand and a new Manager

4) During play each player passes their remaining face-down hand to the player on opposite side of them from the previous round (if you passed left last round, you will now pass right.)

### **Ending The Game**

1) The game ends after 3 complete rounds. 2) Oil Company's players have accelerated are tallied. The player with the most adds 8 Billion to their total score, while the player with the least loses 8 Billion. Ties are split and rounded down. 3) In a 2 player game no player loses score from Oil Company's but the player with the most does earn 8 Billion.

4) The winner is the player with the most money. 5) If there is ever a tie for who would gain points, ties are split, rounded down.

# **Card Descriptions INVESTMENTS:**



Investments are the key to getting rich. Players draft Investments one at a time from their hand to combo and score at the end of the round. MANAGERS:

Managers are a hidden score modifier each player receives at the beginning of the round. Play to your Managers strengths to score big, but don't let your opponents catch on to your strategy or they might just squeeze you out.

SWAG:

Swag in the form of 3 unique types (Car, Copter, Boat) are distributed evenly among certain Investment cards. The player with the most of any 1 type of Swag earns 3 Billion at the end of a round. Ties are split and rounded down.

Hockey Team Start your new Hockey League. The bigger the league the more you make. 1 Hockey Team - 2 Billion

- 2 Hockey Team 4 Billion
- 3 Hockey Team 8 Billion
- 4 Hockey Team 12 Billion
- 5 Hockey Team 18 Billion

Bank The best way to get rich is to stay frugal. Keep a card instead of discarding it after a round.

**Time Warp** Manipulate the space time continuum. Take 2 cards from your hand, and then add the Time Warp to your hand.

**Oil Company** Play the long game. Every business empire requires fuel. Do not discard Oil Company cards. At the end of the game the player with the most Oil Companies earns 8 Billion. The player with the least loses 8 Billion. Ties are split and rounded down.

Cabe Johnson Every 3 Lemonade Chains earns you a bonus of 7 Billion.

Mama Sean Every 3 Pizza Chains earns you a bonus of 4 Billion.

Jim Thornton Every 2 Donut Chains earns you a bonus of 4 Billion.

Perry Black Every Newspaper Chain is granted a +1 Billion bonus.

W.W. Heisenbird Each Swag type with a duplicate is worth a 3 Billion bonus.

**Forest Trump** Each Shrimp Boat is worth a bonus 1 Billion.

Dawn Cheri If you have the most Hockey Teams you gain a 4 Billion bonus.

Stefani Speilburger Each Movie Studio is worth a bonus 2 Billion.

The Dark Lord Functions the same as a Bank. Derrick Plainview Acts as a free Oil Company. Save until the end of the game.

Louis Fittui Before the round begins reveal Louis Fittui to draw a card from the investment deck. Play any 2 Investments on your first turn.

Sully H. Connor All cards without a duplicate are worth 1 Billion
