Introduction

Welcome to Impeachment - the trivia-based card game about modern politics that will have you laughing (or weeping) by the end of the night. Trump impersonations and alcohol recommended, but not required.

Briefing

Congratulations on your successful campaign, Senator!
Unfortunately, you enter the Senate during divided times.
Talks of Impeachment have reached a tipping point and secret votes tallies are being taken in the back halls of Congress. Use your wits, party members, and luck to secure your political future.

(x45) Trials and Tribulations:

From the White House to the Court House. Surreal questions and quotes from modern debates, impeachments, and trials.

(x45) Woke History:

Disco, drugs, and presidential mistresses – various questions on forgotten political history oddities.

(x45) Friend or Foe:

A near endless saga of political flip-flopping told through trivia questions.

(x45) **Breaking News**:

From Harambe to government shutdowns test your knowledge of news stories that made you do a double-take over the past decade.

- 1 **DRINKING** Deck containing 45 cards

(x45) **Culture Wars**: Pour one out for America then fill up a glass Thematic cards to turn Impeachment into a drinking game.

How to play

- 1. Split into two parties (teams) Democrats vs. Republicans.¹
- 2. Shuffle each deck and place them on a table in separate piles.
- 3. The person who voted in the earliest presidential election goes first. If there is a tie, highest dice role wins.

Gameplay

Each player's turn follows the below steps:

1. A member from the opposing team draws a card from the **#POSTS** Deck and reads it out loud.

"They had no definitive proof against Tom Brady or #patriots. If Hillary doesn't have to produce emails, why should Tom? Very unfair! "

- 2. The person whose turn it is must declare out loud whether it is a "Real" social media post from Donald Trump or "Fake News".
- 3. The **#POSTS** card is placed in the discard pile.
- 4. If you answer incorrectly, roll one die.
- 5. If you answered correctly, roll two dice and choose which die to use.
- 6. The opposing team will draw and read one card out loud from the **PLAY** Deck determined by the dice roll.

- 7. Advise with party members and state your answer out loud.
- 8. If you answered incorrectly, the card is discarded, go to step 10.
- 9. If you answered correctly, your team keeps the **PLAY** Deck card.
- 10. The player whose turn it is draws one card from the Culture Wars **DRINKING** Deck. Unless the card states otherwise, the card should be read out loud.
- 11. The closest player to your left from the opposing party goes next.

¹ If you have an odd number of players, players on the smaller team get an extra alternating turn between them per round.

Complementary rules

- 1. Before rolling the die, you may take 2 of your team's cards from the same **PLAY** Deck and exchange them for 1 card from the **PLAY** Deck discard pile of your choice.
- 2. The person whose turn it is gets final say on **#POSTS** & **PLAY** Deck card answers.
- 3. The Culture Wars Deck can be set aside if players are not drinking.

How to win

The first team to obtain the following wins:

- 5 **PLAY** Cards
- At least one card from each **PLAY** Deck
