Game Requirements

Deck of 52 Playing cards (supplied)
2 Monkey Hands rank cards
(supplied)

Deck of Go Bananas cards (supplied)
6 ro sham bo mo bom dice (supplied)
200 Chimps (supplied)

75 \$10 Chimps

50 \$50 Chimps

50 \$100 Chimps

25 \$500 Chimps

Object of Game

Players bet into a community pot
during the course of a hand.

The player holding the best hand at
the end of betting wins pot.

Start of Game

Each player is given 10 \$10, 5 \$50, 4 \$100, 2
\$500 Chimps

Ro Sham Bo Mo Bom is played to determine
dealer

No Limit Texas hold em rules are used.**

2 cards dealt face down to all players

Players to the left of the dealer must put in
blinds \$10 chimps and \$20 chimps

(Blinds double every 15 minutes)

Players bet, check, fold or raise.

1 Card Turned face down (or burned) three
cards turned face up (flop)

Players bet, check, fold or raise.

1 card turned down (Burned)

1 card up (Turn or 4th Street)

Players bet, check, fold or raise.

1 card down (burned)

1 Card up (River)

Players bet, check, fold or raise.

Best 5 cards win.

Any player may go all in at anytime.
Any ties either in the hand or with a go
bananas card, winner will be
determined by Ro Sham Bo Mo Bom

Why Monkey Poker is Different

1. In a hand if all players check, all players must move one seat to the right and play that hand.
2. The winner of each hand must pull a go bananas card and do what it says. If player refuses or is unable to perform task, players can challenge the winner to a ro sham bo bom contest for 5 times the big blind. Winner take all
3. Ranks of hands. Monkey Poker introduces new and exciting hand ranks.
 4. If a player goes out (we have no bananas) they may challenge any other player to a game of ro sham bo mo bom for 5 times the big blind.
Chimps come from bank If challenging player loses they are out and challenged player keeps chimps. If challenger wins they are back in game

Betting

- Check. A bet of zero that does not forfeit interest in pot.
2. Bet or Raise a bet that is bigger than previous bets, all players must match or exceed this bet or else forfeit all interest in the pot.
3. Call a bet equal to a preceding bet that maintains a player's interest in the pot.
4. Fold a surrender of interest in the pot, when a player folds he/she hands in his/her cards and loses any previous bets made during that hand

Monkey poker can be played in
1 of 3 ways

1. **Monkey Poker**

Regular Texas Hold 'em with
some cool monkey faced cards
and chips.

No monkey hands or ro sham bo
rules used.

2. **Monkey Poker**

“Crazy Monkey Version”

Texas Hold'em rules with the
addition of Pocket Monkeys,

Any player dealt the 6 and 8 of
hearts automatically beats any
“Regular Texas Hold'em hand” .
Ties are broken with Ro sham bo
mo bom rules

3. **Monkey Poker**

“All Monkey version”

Texas Hold'em rules with full
Monkey hands, Go bananas and
Ro Sham Bo Mo Bom Rules

Players must choose at beginning of
game which version to play

**All versions allow for players to
challenge any player to rejoin game as
described in “we have no bananas”**

So as they say in Monkey poker

“Lets Peel 'em and deal' em!!
