Changes for Tabletopia



A new day dawns in the digital Stone Age.
PLEASE READ THE RULES CAREFULLY.
Here we only explain the changes between the
digital and physical game.

SETUP

To make it more visible which player is sitting at what position, each player has a **own board**. This is not necessary in the physical game and therefore not included. The tableau is **not limiting the number of cards** each player can have in their group.

To make Paleo more accessible for Tabletopia the 3D elements are flat:

DAY PHASE

1 Put the top card of your deck to the position **most right** on your board until you have 3 face down cards right next to your deck.

2 Then you choose one of the 3 face down cards. Once every player has chosen a card, you flip them simultaneously.

3 If necessary, you move the cards from the 3. or 2. position to the empty **spots**. After that you fill the empty slots again with cards from the top of your deck.

IMPORTANT

Position 1 is considered as **top of your deck** for every other rule in the game. When discarding cards, you first take the cards (in correct order) from your board. In tabletopia it's not allowed to look at all the card backs in your deck.
