

Quips About Christianity

INSTRUCTIONS FOR PLAY

Quips About Christianity is a side-splitting card game for four or more players, who fill in the blanks using stereotypical phrases from Christian doctrine and church sub-culture.

To start the game, each player is dealt ten white cards at random. Each round, a designated leader draws a black card from the deck and reads aloud the incomplete statement or question.

All other players anonymously play one white card (or two or three where required by the blanks) to complete the statement or answer the question on the black card.

The leader shuffles the submitted white cards, before reading out each combination of black and white cards to the entire group. The play adjudged the most humorous by the leader is awarded the black card.

After the completion of each round, players replenish their hands by drawing from the deck so that each player has 10 white cards from which to choose for the next round.

Play passes clockwise until each player has been the round leader an equal amount of times. At the end of a pre-determined number of rounds, players' black cards are tallied to determine the winner of the game.
