

The Round

Each round starts with ACTION cards resolving first. Each player with an ACTION card must show them in the order they played. So if you're the first player, you'd go first. If you're 1st but do not have any ACTION cards, the 2nd player would go if they have any.

Players then play their remaining cards in order of play. You must let the player before you resolve their cards before you can play yours. Make sure you read the cards, depending on the order you play them, they could have a bigger effect!

Strength



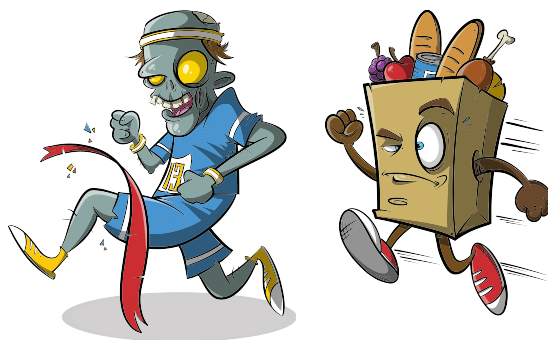
Once all cards have been played, The FIGHTER with the lowest STRENGTH at the end of the round, lost the fight.

If a FIGHTER would go to zero before playing their turn, they have not lost. Their cards must be played before the round is over. Then and only then, can a winner be determined!

Winning The Game

At the end of each ROUND, the player with the lowest STRENGTH lost the round and their FIGHTER. The winning player takes the players fighter as a TROPHY! The winning players' FIGHTER stays on the battlefield until they are beaten or removed by a card(s). The Weapon and Gear cards, however, go to the discard pile.

If you happen to win one of your own kind in a battle, think of it as a rescue mission and you get two points for each of those. So be careful when using cards that switch fighters. This rule does NOT apply when playing with 3 or more players.



Additional Game Notes!

2 players

In a classic fight of 1 vs 1, rules are simple. Do some simple math and the fighter with the highest strength at the end of the round wins. Take your trophy. Keep your fighter on the table. Discard your equipment. Draw more cards. Loser goes first. If it's game point, the loser will roll one 6 sided die and add it to their strength for that round only.

3 or more players

In a game with 3 or more players, all zombies fight against all unicorns. If all players pull the same side, the one with the lowest strength goes into the graveyard and flips another fighter. If there's a tie, roll a die, lowest number goes to the graveyard. The highest fighter on the winning team takes the trophies. All others on that team go to the graveyard and everyone discards their equipment cards. **1 vs many?** In a case of 1 vs many, the solo fighter rolls one 6-sided die and adds that to their strength. In games with 3 or more players, all FIGHTERS are shuffled into a single deck and placed facedown on the battle zone.

IMPORTANT

ALL cards are played facedown until it's your turn. Don't let the enemy know what you've got!

3 Cards per round

That's all the cards you can have in your hand. You can keep cards you've drawn, you just draw that many less next round.

Gear and Weapon cards.

These cards when played only last for that round.

Tiebreaker

In the rare case that you have a tie, keep it simple and leave it to chance. Role a die. Highest number wins the round.

Multiplayer

In multiplayer there can be a lot to keep track of. Keep in mind that while you may be on the same team, ultimately you want the trophies. At the end of the round if you're on the team that wins only the player with the highest score will take the losing teams fighters. The others go to the graveyard. Play it smart, and read the cards. Unlike one vs one, there is no double points for a fighter. All fighters are 1 point.
